DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO Pendleton Heights High School and Middle School:  
From the North: Take I-69 to exit 222. Turn left. Travel into Pendleton (approx. 5 minutes) and the school will be on the left. Middle school is across the street to the east of the high school.

From the South: Take I-69 to exit 219. Turn right. Travel through downtown (approx. 5 minutes) Pendleton and the school will be on the right.

From the East: Take 38W into Pendleton. The school will be on your left.

When you first arrive to PHHS please use the parking facility on the north side (facing 38) and enter the school at the northwest side. At PHMS, you may park on the north side and enter the doors to that parking lot.

Please note that there may be more than one performance area in operation at the same time. Bands and Orchestras at the high school will be performing in the auditorium- just inside entrance 3N. Groups performing at the Middle School will be in the LGI at the crossroads of the entrance hallway.

It is MOST IMPORTANT that you follow and are aware of the following guidelines:

1. Once a performance has begun, NO ONE will be allowed to enter the performance area until **all three** musical selections are complete. Therefore, please plan to arrive no later than 15 – 20 minutes prior to your child's performance time.
2. This location has multiple buildings- be sure to locate and identify the correct performance area prior to entry.
3. Please be courteous of all performers, host officials, and the host facilities. It is allowable and encouraged that you applaud a fine performance.
4. Electronic devices such as cell phones, pagers, and watches should be turned off or placed on a muted setting prior to entry of a performance room.
5. Concessions will be available for you and your child while visiting the performance site. Food or drink is NOT PERMITTED in any performance area.
6. Every ensemble is performing music selected by the teacher for a panel of adjudicators. Ratings, not placings, are provided to each group based upon the rating established by the total panel.
